

Are you interested in volunteering with the Sydney Cancer Centre / Chris O'Brien Lifehouse at RPA?

We are currently recruiting **volunteer drivers** for our Volunteer **Patient Transport Service**. This is a **weekly or fortnightly position** on a fixed weekday, usually **3 to 6 hours for that day**. We do require a 6 month commitment minimum.

You need to have a valid NSW driver's license and a good driving record, along with punctuality, empathy and be at ease with city driving.

The **home transport** entails picking up patients at home (from a certain territory covering most of the Inner West), bringing them to appointments and/or treatments, and bring them back home. Positions available are on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday afternoon roughly from 12.30pm to 4.00pm.

The **shuttle service** operates from 9.00am to 3.00pm between Central Railway Station and RPA Hospital. It runs on a fixed schedule and itinerary. There is currently an opening for Mondays.

If you are **interested in applying for an interview**, please let me know by **Friday, January 20<sup>th</sup>**. I strongly encourage you to talk to friends whom you think might be interested and fit for the job.

We are in great need of volunteer drivers and this is one of our most important services. Without this, certain patients that could stay at home during their months of treatment have to be admitted in hospital, simply due to lack of transport. Patients are incredibly grateful to drivers as they make an enormous difference. Drivers in return feel greatly rewarded.
